1 AN ACT Relating to higher education tuition; and amending RCW 2 28B.15.067.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28B.15.067 and 1996 c 212 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

6 (1) Tuition fees shall be established under the provisions of this 7 chapter.

8 (2) Academic year tuition for full-time students at the state's 9 institutions of higher education for the ((1995-96)) <u>1997-98</u> academic 10 year, other than the summer term, shall be as provided in this 11 subsection.

12 (a) At the University of Washington and Washington State 13 University:

(i) For resident undergraduate students and other resident students
not in graduate study programs or enrolled in programs leading to the
degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of
veterinary medicine, two thousand seven hundred sixty-four dollars;

(ii) For nonresident undergraduate students and other nonresidentstudents not in graduate study programs or enrolled in programs leading

1 to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and 2 doctor of veterinary medicine((-)):

<u>(A) At the University of Washington, ten thousand two hundred</u>
<u>seventy-eight dollars; and</u>

<u>(B) At Washington State University</u>, eight thousand two hundred
sixty-eight dollars;

7 (iii) For resident graduate and law students not enrolled in 8 programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental 9 surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, four thousand four hundred 10 ninety dollars;

(iv) For nonresident graduate and law students not enrolled in programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, eleven thousand six hundred thirty-four dollars;

(v) For resident students enrolled in programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, seven thousand four hundred ninety-seven dollars; and

(vi) For nonresident students enrolled in programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, nineteen thousand four hundred thirty-one dollars.

(b) At the regional universities and The Evergreen State College:
(i) For resident undergraduate and all other resident students not
in graduate study programs, two thousand forty-five dollars;

(ii) For nonresident undergraduate and all other nonresident
 students not in graduate study programs, seven thousand nine hundred
 ninety-two dollars;

(iii) For resident graduate students, three thousand four hundredforty-three dollars; and

30 (iv) For nonresident graduate students, eleven thousand seventy-one31 dollars.

32 (c) At the community colleges:

(i) For resident students, one thousand two hundred twelve dollars;and

(ii) For nonresident students, five thousand one hundred sixty-twodollars and fifty cents.

3 (a) At the University of Washington and Washington State
4 University:

5 (i) For resident undergraduate students and other resident students 6 not in graduate study programs or enrolled in programs leading to the 7 degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of 8 veterinary medicine, two thousand eight hundred seventy-five dollars;

9 (ii) For nonresident undergraduate students and other nonresident 10 students not in graduate study programs or enrolled in programs leading 11 to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and 12 doctor of veterinary medicine((τ)):

(A) At the University of Washington, eleven thousand one hundred
 thirty dollars; and

15 (B) At Washington State University, nine thousand four hundred 16 ninety-one dollars;

(iii) For resident graduate and law students not enrolled in programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, four thousand six hundred sixty-nine dollars;

(iv) For nonresident graduate and law students not enrolled in programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, twelve thousand one hundred dollars;

(v) For resident students enrolled in programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, seven thousand seven hundred ninety-seven dollars; and

(vi) For nonresident students enrolled in programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, twenty thousand two hundred nine dollars.

32 (b) At the regional universities and The Evergreen State College: 33 (i) For resident undergraduate and all other resident students not 34 in graduate study programs, two thousand one hundred twenty-seven 35 dollars;

(ii) For nonresident undergraduate and all other nonresident
 students not in graduate study programs, eight thousand three hundred
 twelve dollars;

(iii) For resident graduate students, three thousand five hundred
 eighty-one dollars; and

3 (iv) For nonresident graduate students, eleven thousand five4 hundred fourteen dollars.

5 (c) At the community colleges:

6 (i) For resident students, one thousand two hundred sixty-one 7 dollars; and

8 (ii) For nonresident students, five thousand three hundred sixty-9 nine dollars and fifty cents.

(4) The tuition fees established under this chapter shall not apply
to high school students enrolling in community colleges under RCW
28A.600.300 through 28A.600.395.

13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. If any provision of this act or its 14 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the 15 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other 16 persons or circumstances is not affected.
