- 1 AN ACT Relating to salmon harvest reporting; and adding a new
- 2 section to chapter 75.08 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 75.08 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Beginning March 1, 1998, and each March 1st thereafter, the
- 7 department shall submit a report to the appropriate standing committees
- 8 of the legislature identifying the total salmon and steelhead harvest
- 9 of the preceding season. This report shall include the final
- 10 commercial harvests and the best available estimate of recreational
- 11 harvests. By September 15th of each year, the department shall update
- 12 its report by including final estimates of recreational harvests. At
- 13 a minimum, the report shall clearly identify:
- 14 (1) The total treaty tribal and nontribal harvests by species and
- 15 by management unit;
- 16 (2) Where and why the nontribal harvest does not meet the full
- 17 allocation allowed under United States v. Washington, 384 F. Supp. 312
- 18 (1974) (Boldt I) including a summary of the key policies within the

- 1 management plan that result in a less than full nontribal allocation;

- 3 (3) The location and quantity of salmon and steelhead harvested
- 4 under the wastage provisions of United States v. Washington, 384 F.
- 5 Supp. 312 (1974).
