AN ACT Relating to petitions to be filed with the government; amending RCW 29.79.090, 29.79.100, 29.79.110, and 29.79.490; and adding a new section to chapter 29.79 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 29.79.090 and 1982 c 116 s 9 are each amended to read 6 as follows:

7 <u>(1)</u> Petitions for proposing measures for submission to the 8 legislature at its next regular session, shall be substantially in the 9 following form:

<u>"</u>WARNING

Every person who signs this petition with any other than his or her true name, knowingly signs more than one of these petitions, signs this petition when he or she is not a legal voter, or makes any false statement on this petition may be punished by fine or imprisonment or both.

PETITION FOR REFERENDUM

12 To the Honorable , Secretary of State of the State of 13 Washington:

We, the undersigned citizens and legal voters of the State of 14 Washington, respectfully order and direct that Referendum Measure No. 15 , filed to revoke a (or part or parts of a) bill that (concise 16 17 statement required by RCW 29.79.055) and that was passed by the 18 legislature of the State of Washington at the last regular (special) session of said legislature, shall be referred to the people 19 20 of the state for their approval or rejection at the regular (special) election to be held on the day of November, 19. . .; and each 21 of us for himself or herself says: I have personally signed this 22 23 petition; I am a legal voter of the State of Washington, in the city 24 (or town) and county written after my name, my residence address is correctly stated, and I have knowingly signed this petition only once. 25

5 (2) Space must be provided on each petition for the person or 6 persons who procured the signatures to both sign and print his or her 7 name and address certifying that, to his or her knowledge, the 8 signatures on the petition are valid.

9 (3) In addition, the following must be included and completed on 10 each referendum petition where compensation, pay, or other 11 consideration is provided to the person circulating, soliciting, or 12 procuring signatures on that petition in at least twenty-point, bold-13 faced type at the top of each petition:

14 <u>"SIGNATURE GATHERERS ARE BEING PAID BY (type or</u> 15 legibly print in ink the name of the group, organization, or 16 person paying for the signature gathering) TO CIRCULATE THIS 17 <u>PETITION."</u>

18 The requirements under this subsection (3) are not required on any 19 other petition for the same referendum measure if compensation, pay, or 20 other consideration is not provided to the person circulating, 21 soliciting, or procuring signatures on that particular petition.

22 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. A new section is added to chapter 29.79 RCW 23 to read as follows:

24 A person who provides compensation, pay, or other consideration to 25 another person to circulate, solicit, or procure signatures on an 26 initiative or referendum petition shall keep records of the person who 27 procured the signatures for consideration on each separate petition. 28 Space must be provided on each petition to number the petition to assist in tracking the signature gatherers. These records must be kept 29 30 current and must be submitted to the secretary of state when the petitions are filed. 31

32 Sec. 5. RCW 29.79.490 and 1993 c 256 s 4 are each amended to read 33 as follows:

Every person ((shall be)) is guilty of a gross misdemeanor who: (1) For any consideration or gratuity or promise thereof, signs or declines to sign any initiative or referendum petition; or 1 (2) Provides or receives consideration for soliciting or procuring 2 signatures on an initiative or referendum petition if any part of the 3 consideration is based upon the number of signatures solicited or 4 procured, or offers to provide or agrees to receive such consideration 5 any of which is based on the number of signatures solicited or 6 procured; or

7 (3) Gives or offers any consideration or gratuity to any person to
8 induce him or her to sign or not to sign or to vote for or against any
9 initiative or referendum measure; or

10 (4) Interferes with or attempts to interfere with the right of any 11 voter to sign or not to sign an initiative or referendum petition or 12 with the right to vote for or against an initiative or referendum 13 measure by threats, intimidation, or any other corrupt means or 14 practice; or

(5) Receives, handles, distributes, pays out, or gives away, 15 directly or indirectly, money or any other thing of value contributed 16 17 by or received from any person, firm, association, or corporation whose residence or principal office is, or the majority of whose members or 18 19 stockholders have their residence outside, the state of Washington, for 20 any service rendered for the purpose of aiding in procuring signatures upon any initiative or referendum petition or for the purpose of aiding 21 in the adoption or rejection of any initiative or referendum measure: 22 23 PROVIDED, That this subsection shall not apply to or prohibit any 24 activity which is properly reported in accordance with the applicable 25 provisions of chapter 42.17 RCW; or

26 (6) Circulates, solicits, or procures, or attempts to procure, signatures upon an initiative or referendum petition that fails to meet 27 the requirements of RCW 29.79.080, 29.79.090, 29.79.100, or 29.79.110, 28 including, where applicable, the requirements that: (a) The statement 29 30 be included indicating that signature gatherers are being paid or 31 otherwise receiving consideration to gather signatures; and (b) the name of the group, organization, or person paying for signature 32 gathering be inserted. 33

A gross misdemeanor under this section is punishable to the same section as a gross misdemeanor that is punishable under RCW 9A.20.021.

36 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** If any provision of this act or its 37 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the

- 1 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
- 2 persons or circumstances is not affected.

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
