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## HOUSE BILL 1781

- 1 AN ACT Relating to the monitoring of supervised offenders under the
- 2 jurisdiction of the state department of corrections; adding a new
- 3 section to chapter 43.10 RCW; creating a new section; and making
- 4 appropriations.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that increased
- 7 communications between local law enforcement officers and the state
- 8 department of corrections' community corrections officers improves
- 9 public safety. Improved public safety is accomplished through shared
- 10 monitoring and supervision of offenders living in the community under
- 11 the jurisdiction of the state department of corrections. Participating
- 12 local law enforcement agencies and the local offices of the state
- 13 department of corrections have implemented, on a pilot basis, the
- 14 supervision management and recidivist tracking program, whereby each
- 15 entity provides mutual assistance to the other with supervising
- 16 offenders living within the boundaries of local law enforcement
- 17 agencies. Through shared information and coordinated supervision, the
- 18 supervision management and recidivist tracking program has helped local
- 19 law enforcement solve crimes faster or prevented future criminal

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activity by reporting offender's sentence violations in a more timely manner to state community corrections officers. Information collected 2 in the field by local law enforcement related to serious offenders 3 4 under the jurisdiction of the state department of corrections is electronically transferred to the office of the attorney general's 5 homicide investigative tracking system. Field information entered into 6 7 system is electronically transferred to the department of 8 corrections' community corrections officer responsible for the offender 9 and remains in the homicide investigative tracking system where it is 10 accessible to the department of corrections and law enforcement throughout the state. The expansion of the supervision management and 11 12 recidivist tracking program is needed to improve public safety for law-13 abiding citizens throughout the state.

NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 43.10 RCW to read as follows:

16 The office of the attorney general may contract with the city of Redmond's police department, the Washington state department of 17 18 corrections, or any other state, local, or private agency necessary for implementation of supervision management and recidivist tracking 19 program partnerships to include the development of a state-wide 20 computer linkage between the attorney general's homicide investigative 21 22 tracking system, local police departments, and the state department of 23 corrections. Moneys shall be spent for computer hardware and software, 24 initial start-up costs, and other costs fundamental to 25 establishment of supervision management and recidivist tracking program partnerships in local communities. 26

27 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The sum of one million five hundred thousand 28 dollars, or as much as may be necessary, is appropriated for the fiscal 29 year ending June 30, 1998, from the state general fund to the office of the attorney general for the purpose of implementing the supervision 30 31 management and recidivist tracking partnership program. 32 five hundred thousand dollars, or as much as may be necessary, is 33 appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, from the state 34 general fund to the office of the attorney general for the purpose of

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- 1 implementing the supervision management and recidivist tracking
- 2 partnership program.

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
