- 1 AN ACT Relating to city and town utility taxes; amending RCW
- 2 35.21.870; and repealing RCW 35.21.871 and 35A.82.070.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 35.21.870 and 1984 c 225 s 6 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (((1) No)) <u>After the effective date of this act, a city or town may</u>
- 7 <u>not</u> impose a tax <u>or increase the rate of tax</u> on the privilege of
- 8 conducting an electrical energy, natural gas, steam energy, or
- 9 telephone business ((at a rate which exceeds six percent)) unless the
- 10 rate is first approved by a majority of the voters of the city or town
- 11 voting on such a proposition.
- 12 ((2) If a city or town is imposing a rate of tax under subsection
- 13 (1) of this section in excess of six percent on April 20, 1982, the
- 14 city or town shall decrease the rate to a rate of six percent or less
- 15 by reducing the rate each year on or before November 1st by ordinances
- 16 to be effective on January 1st of the succeeding year, by an amount
- 17 equal to one-tenth the difference between the tax rate on April 20,
- 18 1982, and six percent.

- Nothing in this subsection prohibits a city or town from reducing its rates by amounts greater than the amounts required in this subsection.
- Voter approved rate increases under subsection (1) of this section shall not be included in the computations under this subsection.))
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The following acts or parts of acts are each 7 repealed:
- 8 (1) RCW 35.21.871 and 1986 c 70 s 3; and
- 9 (2) RCW 35A.82.070 and 1986 c 70 s 6.
