- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28B.15.910 and 1993 sp.s. c 18 s 31 are each amended 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Except for revenue waived under programs listed in subsection
- 7 (3) of this section, and unless otherwise expressly provided in the
- 8 omnibus state appropriations act, the total amount of operating fees
- 9 revenue waived, exempted, or reduced by a state university, a regional
- 10 university, The Evergreen State College, or the community colleges as
- 11 a whole, shall not exceed the percentage of total gross authorized
- 12 operating fees revenue set forth below. As used in this section,

(4) It is the intent of the legislature that general tax support 1 2 for institutions of higher education shall not increase as a result of 3 increasing above the 1993 statutory level the percentage of estimated 4 operating fees revenue that institutions may waive. For the purpose of estimating tuition and fees revenue, the legislature may assume that 5 the maximum percentage of operating fees revenue that the following 6 institutions of higher education may waive is as follows: Eight 7 percent for Central Washington University, six percent for The 8 Evergreen State College, and twenty percent for Washington State 9 10 University.
