- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- MEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that it is critical for students to achieve basic reading skills by the end of the second grade. The legislature also finds that student reading skills need to be assessed in the second grade. The purpose of the second grade reading assessment is to provide teachers with an accurate evaluation of student reading progress and provide teachers with information needed to improve instructional strategies. Therefore, the legislature intends to develop a grant program for reading in the primary grades.
