- 1 AN ACT Relating to exempting new businesses from business and
- 2 occupation tax; and adding a new section to chapter 82.04 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 82.04 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) This chapter shall not apply to the gross sales or the gross 7 income received by a new business.
- (2) As used in this section: 8
- 9 (a) "New business" means a business that obtained or was required 10 to obtain a registration certificate under RCW 82.32.030 for the first time during the thirty-six months immediately preceding the date in 11 which an exemption is claimed under this section. 12 For out-of-state 13 entities first engaging in business in this state, "new business" means 14 a person or company, as defined in RCW 82.04.030, located outside this 15 state that obtained or was required to obtain registration with any

- state, federal, or foreign agency for the first time during the thirty-16
- 17 six months immediately preceding the date in which an exemption is
- claimed under this section. 18

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(b) "New business" does not include:

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- 1 (i) A business that has been restructured, reorganized, or 2 transferred, unless the majority of the activities to be conducted 3 after restructuring, reorganization, or transferral are significantly 4 different from the activities previously conducted;
 - (ii) A new branch location or other facility; or

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6 (iii) A business that is substantially similar to a business 7 currently operated, or operated within the past ten years, by the same 8 principals.

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
