- 1 AN ACT Relating to protection of groundwater aquifers near
- 2 department of transportation rights of way; and adding a new section to
- 3 chapter 47.28 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 47.28 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 In order to protect groundwater aquifers that are the sole source
- 8 of drinking water for a given jurisdiction and in order to prevent the
- 9 contamination of watersheds that are controlled for the purpose of
- 10 drinking water quality, in accordance with rules of the department of
- 11 health, from harmful chemicals applied during vegetation management
- 12 along transportation right of ways, the department of transportation
- 13 shall serve written notification of upcoming chemical treatments of
- 14 noxious weeds within state right of way to those cities and counties
- 15 having Group A water systems that serve a minimum of twenty thousand
- 16 residences within their respective jurisdictions.
- 17 In order to help the department of transportation better serve the
- 18 unique needs of cities and counties and in order to ensure that
- 19 chemical applications do not impact significant water sources, the

- 1 legislature strongly urges local jurisdictions to submit to their
- 2 regional department of transportation office, the documentation
- 3 required by WAC 246-290-135 as well as the local jurisdiction's policy
- 4 on the use of chemicals to control noxious weeds.
