- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 10.82.090 and 1995 c 291 s 7 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 Financial obligations imposed in a judgment in a criminal case
- 7 shall bear interest from the date of the judgment until payment((, at
- 8 the rate applicable to civil judgments)) is paid in full. Interest
- 9 rates on judgments shall not exceed six percent in any twelve-month
- 10 period. All nonrestitution interest retained by the court shall be
- 11 split twenty-five percent to the state treasurer for deposit in the

public safety and education account as provided in RCW 43.08.250,

- 13 twenty-five percent to the state treasurer for deposit in the judicial
- 14 information system account as provided in RCW 2.68.020, twenty-five
- 15 percent to the county current expense fund, and twenty-five percent to
- 16 the county current expense fund to fund local courts.
