- 9 vendors or contractors from whom the state agency makes purchases or
- 10 contracts for services, construction, or maintenance, to lobby or
- 11 contact the legislature, members of the legislature, or legislative
- 12 staff regarding pending legislation under consideration by the
- 13 legislature or proposed legislation that may be considered by the
