- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28A.600.200 and 1990 c 33 s 502 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6 Each school district board of directors is hereby granted and shall
- 7 exercise the authority to control, supervise and regulate the conduct
- 8 of interschool athletic activities and other interschool
- 9 extracurricular activities of an athletic, cultural, social o
- 10 recreational nature for students of the district. A board of directors
- 11 may delegate control, supervision and regulation of any such activity
- 12 to the Washington Interscholastic Activities Association or any other
- 13 voluntary nonprofit entity and compensate such entity for services
- 14 provided, subject to the following conditions:
- 15 (1) The voluntary nonprofit entity shall submit an annual report to
- 16 the state board of education of student appeal determinations, assets,
- 17 and financial receipts and disbursements at such time and in such
- 18 detail as the state board shall establish by rule;

1 (2) The voluntary nonprofit entity shall not discriminate in 2 connection with employment or membership upon its governing board, or 3 otherwise in connection with any function it performs, on the basis of 4 race, creed, national origin, sex or marital status;

- (3) Any rules and policies applied by the voluntary nonprofit entity which govern student participation in any interschool activity shall be written and subject to the annual review and approval of the state board of education at such time as it shall establish;
- 9 (4) All amendments and repeals of such rules and policies shall be 10 subject to the review and approval of the state board; ((and))
- (5) Such rules and policies shall provide for notice of the reasons 11 and a fair opportunity to contest such reasons prior to a final 12 13 determination to reject a student's request to participate in or to continue in an interschool activity. Any such decision shall be 14 15 considered a decision of the school district conducting the activity in 16 which the student seeks to participate or was participating and may be 17 RCW 28A.645.010 through ((28A.645.030)) appealed pursuant to 28A.645.020; and 18
- 19 (6) Review under subsection (5) of this section shall be heard
 20 expeditiously by the court without a jury, confined to the record, and
 21 limited to whether the voluntary nonprofit entity governing student
 22 participation in the interschool activity acted arbitrarily,
 23 capriciously, or contrary to law.
