- 1 AN ACT Relating to the city hardship assistance program; and
- 2 amending RCW 47.26.164.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 47.26.164 and 1991 c 342 s 60 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- The board shall adopt reasonable rules necessary to implement the city hardship assistance program as recommended by the road jurisdiction study.
- 9 The following criteria shall be used to implement the program:
- 10 (1) Only those cities with a net gain in cost responsibility due to
- 11 jurisdictional transfers ((in chapter 342, Laws of)) from the state
- 12 <u>highway system before January 1,</u> 1991, as determined by the board, may
- 13 participate;
- 14 (2) Cities with populations of fifteen thousand or less, as
- 15 determined by the office of financial management, may participate;
- 16 (3) The board shall develop criteria and procedures under which
- 17 eligible cities may request funding for rehabilitation projects ((on
- 18 city streets acquired under chapter 342, Laws of 1991)); and

1 (4) The board shall also be authorized to allocate funds from the 2 hardship account to cities with a population under twenty thousand to 3 offset extraordinary costs associated with the transfer of roadways 4 ((other than pursuant to chapter 342, Laws of 1991,)) that occur after 5 January 1, 1991.
