- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 43.330 RCW to read as follows:
- 8 (1) The department shall work with local communities to develop a
- 9 consolidated film permit processing system designed to coordinate the
- 10 issuance of state and local permits to a person who proposes to make a
- 11 motion picture, television show, television commercial, or other
- 12 visually recorded production.
- 13 (2) The department shall consult with state and local government
- 14 agencies to identify sites for making visually recorded productions
- 15 under terms and conditions determined by the state or local government
- 16 agency having jurisdiction over the sites.
- 17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 35.21 RCW
- 18 to read as follows:

- A city or town may establish a consolidated film permit process system designed to reduce the time necessary to obtain a permit needed to make a motion picture, television show, television commercial, or other visually recorded production within the boundaries of the city or town.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 35A.11 RCW to read as follows:
- A code city may establish a consolidated film permit process system designed to reduce the time necessary to obtain a permit needed to make a motion picture, television show, television commercial, or other visually recorded production within the boundaries of the code city.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. A new section is added to chapter 36.01 RCW to read as follows:
- A county may establish a consolidated film permit process system designed to reduce the time necessary to obtain a permit needed to make a motion picture, television show, television commercial, or other visually recorded production within the boundaries of the county.
