- 6 The WorkFirst program operated by the department to meet the 7 federal work requirements specified in P.L. 104-183 shall contain a job
- 8 search component. The component shall consist of instruction on how to
- 9 secure a job and assisted job search activities to locate and retain
- 10 employment. Nonexempt recipients of temporary assistance for needy
- 11 families shall participate in an initial job search for no more than
- 12 four consecutive weeks. If a recipient fails to find paid employment
