- 1 AN ACT Relating to creating a job search component within the
- 2 WorkFirst program; and adding a new section to chapter 74.08A RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 74.08A RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 The WorkFirst program operated by the department to meet the
- 7 federal work requirements specified in P.L. 104-183 shall contain a job
- 8 search component. The component shall consist of instruction on how to
- <u>-</u>
- 9 secure a job and assisted job search activities to locate and retain
- 10 employment. Nonexempt recipients of temporary assistance for needy
- 11 families shall participate in the job search component for no more than
- 12 four consecutive weeks. If a recipient fails to find paid employment
- 13 during the initial four weeks of the job search component, the
- 14 department shall assess the recipient pursuant to RCW 74.08A.260. The
- 15 department shall refer recipients having completed four weeks of the
- 16 job search component to work activities that will develop their skills
- 17 or knowledge to make them more employable, including additional job

- 1 search and job readiness assistance. A recipient's participation in
- 2 the job search component shall not last longer than six weeks.
