- 8 fire fighter, the driver of a vehicle approaching an intersection
- 9 controlled with a traffic control signal that is not displaying a
- 10 green, red, or yellow indication to that approaching vehicle, shall
- 11 stop and yield the right of way in accordance with RCW 46.61.180(1) and
- 12 46.61.185.
