1 $((\frac{b}{c}))$ (c) For taxing districts for which a limit factor is authorized under RCW 84.55.0101, the lesser of the limit factor authorized under that section or one hundred six percent; $((\frac{c}{c}))$ (d) For all other districts, the lesser of one hundred six percent or one hundred percent plus inflation; and $((\frac{c}{c}))$ (4) "Regular property taxes" has the meaning given it in RCW 84.04.140.
