- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 81.104 RCW
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 Any regional transit authority imposing taxes under this chapter
- 9 shall consult with the department of community, trade, and economic
- 10 development to explore the potential for developing contracting methods
- 11 and procedures that encourage the establishment of a manufacturing base
- 12 in the state of Washington for the purpose of constructing and
- 13 assembling commuter and light rail train sets and components. The
- 14 regional transit authority shall report its findings and
- 15 recommendations to the legislative transportation committee by January
- 16 1, 1999.
