- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.43 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 The powers and duties of the commercial vehicle enforcement
- officers and commercial vehicle officers are to enforce state and 8
- 9 federal laws and regulations relating to motor transport carriers and
- 10 other related statutes and regulations as directed by law. Commercial
- vehicle enforcement officers have the same law enforcement and arrest 11
- authority as commissioned Washington state patrol officers as it 12
- 13 relates to situations involving commercial vehicles. The patrol shall
- 14 provide the training necessary to ensure the safety and success of the
- 15 officers in the above-assigned duties.
