- TO THE HONORABLE TOM CRONIN, PRESIDENT OF WHITMAN COLLEGE, AND TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF WHITMAN COLLEGE:
- We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of
- 4 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully
- 5 represent and petition as follows:
- 6 WHEREAS, Whitman College was created by the Legislative Assembly of
- 7 the Territory of Washington on December 20, 1859; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The original act created a nine-member board of trustees;
- 9 and
- 10 WHEREAS, The Washington state Constitution was ratified by the
- 11 people at an election held October 1, 1889; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Article XXVII, Section 2 of the state Constitution
- 13 provides: "All laws remain in force in the Territory of Washington
- 14 which are not repugnant to this Constitution, shall remain in force
- 15 until they expire by their own limitation, or are altered or repealed
- 16 by the legislature: . . . "; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Whitman College is a private institution of higher
- 18 education and its governance is not regulated by the Legislature; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Statutes governing Whitman college are not codified in the
- 20 Revised Code of Washington; and

1 WHEREAS, Whitman College may regulate its corporate concerns by 2 amendment to its bylaws;
