1 TO THE HONORABLE WILLIAM J. CLINTON, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED 2 STATES, AND TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE 3 OF REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF 4 THE UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:

5 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of 6 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully 7 represent and petition as follows:

8 WHEREAS, The Bonneville Power Administration was initially created 9 to provide low-cost power to rural areas, a tradition that it maintains 10 today; and

11 WHEREAS, The Pacific Northwest enjoys low electricity rates, thanks 12 largely to the Bonneville Power Administration; and

13 WHEREAS, Those rates would be seriously jeopardized by the sale of 14 the Bonneville Power Administration; and

WHEREAS, The sale of the Bonneville Power Administration would threaten the long-standing relationship the Bonneville Power Administration has established with the Northwest's public utility districts and rural electric associations; and

19 WHEREAS, The Bonneville Power Administration currently contributes 20 a portion of its revenue to salmon restoration, and there is no

1 guarantee those funds would be available if the Bonneville Power 2 Administration is sold;

3 NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the 4 President and Congress agree not to sell the Bonneville Power 5 Administration and rather to allow it to continue fulfilling its 6 mission of providing low-cost power to the Pacific Northwest.

7 BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately 8 transmitted to the Honorable William J. Clinton, President of the 9 United States, the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker 10 of the House of Representatives, and each member of Congress from the 11 State of Washington.
