1 AN ACT Relating to the taxation of activities conducted for an
2 agricultural commodity commission or board; and adding a new section to
3 chapter 82.04 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 82.04 RCW
6 to read as follows:

7 (1) This chapter does not apply to any nonprofit organization in
8 respect to amounts received from an agricultural commodity commission
9 or agricultural commodity board created by state statute or a
10 commission or board created under chapter 15.24, 15.26, 15.28, 15.44,
11 15.65, 15.66, 15.88, or 16.67 RCW.

12 (2) As used in this section, "nonprofit organization" means an
13 organization that: Is exempt from federal income tax under 26 U.S.C.
14 Section 501(c)(3), 501(c)(5), 501(c)(6), or 521; and has the same
15 objectives for which the agricultural commodity commission or
16 agricultural commodity board was formed.
