1            AN ACT Relating to the capital budget; amending 1997 c . . . (SSB  
2 6063) s 123 (uncodified); adding new sections to 1997 c . . . (SSB  
3 6063); creating a new section; making appropriations and authorizing  
4 expenditures for capital improvements; and declaring an emergency.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.** A supplemental capital budget is hereby  
7 adopted and, subject to the provisions set forth in this act, the  
8 several dollar amounts hereinafter specified, or so much thereof as  
9 shall be sufficient to accomplish the purposes designated, are hereby  
10 appropriated and authorized to be incurred for capital projects during  
11 the period ending June 30, 1999, out of the several funds specified in  
12 this act.
