- 1 AN ACT Relating to improving wildlife resources and air
- 2 transportation; creating a new section; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that the department of
- 5 fish and wildlife manages property in the state where the department
- 6 has abandoned use of the property for fish hatchery operations and
- 7 where the location of the property impedes further development of air
- 8 transportation facilities. The department shall identify all such
- 9 properties in the state and shall immediately begin to work with local
- 10 governments in the same counties in which the properties are located to
- 11 explore land exchanges to benefit the state's wildlife resources and to
- 12 facilitate improved air transportation.
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 14 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 15 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
- 16 immediately.
