## SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL 5062

State of Washington 55th Legislature 1997 Regular Session

AN ACT Relating to state agencies issuing federal credentials or documents; adding a new section to chapter 19.02 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 43.07 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 43.22 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 50.12 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 82.02 RCW; creating a new section; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

8 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature intends to simplify the 9 process of registering and licensing businesses in this state by 10 authorizing state agencies to provide consolidated forms, instructions, service locations, and other operations whenever coordination of these 11 12 functions would benefit individual businesses and the business community of this state. To further this goal, agencies participating 13 14 in the master business license program should be able to contract with 15 the federal internal revenue service, or other appropriate federal 16 agency, to issue a conditional federal employer identification number, 17 or other federal credentials or documents, at the same time that a business applies for registration or licensing with any state agency. 18

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<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 19.02 RCW
to read as follows:

3 (1) The director may contract with the federal internal revenue 4 service, or other appropriate federal agency, to issue conditional federal employer identification numbers, or other federal credentials 5 or documents, at specified offices and locations of the agency in 6 7 conjunction with any application for state licenses under this chapter. 8 (2) To the extent permitted by any contract entered under 9 subsection (1) of this section, the department may contract, under 10 chapter 39.34 RCW, with any agency of state or local government which 11 is participating in the master licensing program to issue conditional 12 federal employer identification numbers, or other federal credentials 13 or documents, in conjunction with applications for state licenses under this chapter. 14

15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 43.07 RCW 16 to read as follows:

17 The secretary of state may contract with the federal internal 18 revenue service, or other appropriate federal agency, to issue 19 conditional federal employer identification numbers, or other federal 20 credentials or documents, at specified offices and locations of the 21 agency in conjunction with any application for state licenses under 22 chapter 19.02 RCW.

23 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. A new section is added to chapter 43.22 RCW 24 to read as follows:

The director may contract with the federal internal revenue service, or other appropriate federal agency, to issue conditional federal employer identification numbers, or other federal credentials or documents, at specified offices and locations of the agency in conjunction with any application for state licenses under chapter 19.02 RCW.

31 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 5. A new section is added to chapter 50.12 RCW 32 to read as follows:

33 The commissioner may contract with the federal internal revenue 34 service, or other appropriate federal agency, to issue conditional 35 federal employer identification numbers, or other federal credentials 36 or documents, at specified offices and locations of the agency in conjunction with any application for state licenses under chapter 19.02
RCW.

3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 6. A new section is added to chapter 82.02 RCW 4 to read as follows:

5 The director may contract with the federal internal revenue 6 service, or other appropriate federal agency, to issue conditional 7 federal employer identification numbers, or other federal credentials 8 or documents, at specified offices and locations of the agency in 9 conjunction with any application for state licenses under chapter 19.02 10 RCW.

11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 7. This act is necessary for the immediate 12 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the 13 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect 14 July 1, 1997.

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
