1 AN ACT Relating to injunctive relief; reenacting and amending RCW 2 9A.46.060; and adding a new section to chapter 7.40 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 7.40 RCW 5 to read as follows:

On a motion from a parent or guardian of a child under the age of eighteen, an injunction may be granted to restrain a person over age eighteen from contact with that child upon a showing that contact with the person to be enjoined is detrimental to the welfare of the child.

33 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. If any provision of this act or its 34 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the 35 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other 36 persons or circumstances is not affected.
