- AN ACT Relating to disclosure of students' social security numbers;
- 2 and adding a new section to chapter 28A.320 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.320 5 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 (1) School districts and public schools shall not request the 7 disclosure of a student's federal social security number, except as 8 provided in subsection (2) of this section.
- 9 (2) A school district or public school may request the disclosure 10 of a student's federal social security number for the sole purpose of 11 seeking medicaid reimbursement for covered services to eligible 12 students under RCW 74.09.5241 through 74.09.5256.
- Any school district or public school requesting the disclosure of a student's federal social security number under this subsection must use a form that contains a disclosure statement printed on the form.
- 16 The disclosure statement must include the following information:
- 17 (a) The student's social security number is being requested for the 18 sole purpose of seeking medical reimbursement for covered services to 19 eligible students under RCW 74.09.5241 through 74.09.5256; and

- 1 (b) What the consequences are for not providing the student's 2 federal social security number.
- 3 (3) It shall be unlawful for any public school or public school 4 district to deny a student any right, benefit, or privilege provided by 5 law because the student or the student's parent or legal guardian 6 refuses to disclose the student's federal social security number.
