1 AN ACT Relating to student counts for state general apportionment
2 funding; and adding a new section to chapter 28A.630 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.630
5 RCW to read as follows:

6 (1) The superintendent of public instruction shall establish a two-
7 year pilot program to permit programs among districts where students
8 who take classes part-time at a nonresident district are counted only
9 at their school of residence for the purposes of state general
10 apportionment funding. Each pilot program shall be among a minimum of
11 three school districts. Districts participating in the program shall
12 enter into agreements governing the program.

13 (2) The superintendent of public instruction shall adopt rules as
14 necessary under chapter 34.05 RCW to carry out this section.

15 (3) The superintendent of public instruction shall submit a report
16 to the legislature by December 31, 1999, on the benefits of the pilot
17 program, any difficulties encountered by the districts in the program,
18 any difficulties encountered by the superintendent of public

1 instruction, and recommendations regarding the continuation of the
2 program.

3 (4) This section expires December 31, 1999.
