- 2 75.12.390.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 75.12.390 and 1989 c 172 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 Commercial bottom trawling for food fish and shellfish is unlawful
- 7 in all areas of ((Hood Canal south of a line projected from Tala Point
- 8 to Foulweather Bluff and in Puget Sound south of a line projected from
- 9 Foulweather Bluff to Double Bluff and including all marine waters east
- 10 of Whidbey Island and Camano Island)) the Strait of Juan de Fuca east
- 11 of the Sekiu river, the Strait of Georgia, the San Juan Islands,
- 12 Admiralty Inlet, Puget Sound, and Hood Canal. All waters in marine
- 13 area codes five through thirteen are closed to commercial bottom
- 14 trawling for food fish and shellfish.
