1 AN ACT Relating to vehicles boarding ferries; adding a new section 2 to chapter 46.61 RCW; and adding a new section to chapter 47.60 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW 5 to read as follows:

6 It is a traffic infraction for a driver of a motor vehicle 7 intending to board a Washington state ferry, to block a residential 8 driveway while waiting to board the ferry. Jurisdiction for 9 enforcement of this section is determined in accordance with RCW 10 47.60.275.

11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 47.60 RCW 12 to read as follows:

The department shall take steps to mitigate problems associated with lengthy ferry queues, including the blockage of residential driveways, by establishing a maximum queue length for each ferry terminal, the end of which must occur five feet before the first

- 1 residential driveway, and by implementing procedures and any needed
- 2 infrastructural changes to enforce this requirement.
