- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28A.160.210 and 1989 c 178 s 20 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6 In addition to other powers and duties, the state board of
- 7 education shall adopt rules ((and regulations)) governing the training
- 8 ((and)), qualifications ((of school bus drivers)), and eligibility
- 9 requirements for district employees who transport students in school
- 10 <u>buses or other motor vehicles</u>. Such rules ((and regulations)) shall be
