- 1 AN ACT Relating to a person potentially liable for a hazardous
- 2 substance release; and adding a new section to chapter 70.105D RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 70.105D 5 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 If a potentially liable person has completely complied with the
- 7 department's remedial order under RCW 70.105D.050, or with a settlement
- 8 in the form of a consent decree under RCW 70.105D.040, or both, and the
- 9 department has not discovered further harm from the hazardous substance
- 10 release for three years from the date of final compliance, the
- 11 potentially liable person may not be held further liable for harm from
- 12 the release. Prior to the expiration of the three-year period, the
- 13 department may request that the potentially liable person provide
- 14 monitoring and investigation to determine that the site poses an
- 15 acceptable or no potential for harm due to the release of hazardous
- 16 substances.

- 1 A release made by the potentially liable person at the same or
- 2 another site after the expiration of the three-year period is a new
- 3 violation of this chapter.
