- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 3 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.36.070 and 1975 1st ex.s. c 260 s 9A.36.070 are 4 each amended to read as follows:
- 5 (1) A person is guilty of coercion if by use of a threat <u>and</u>
  6 <u>without lawful authority</u> he <u>or she</u> compels or induces a person to
  7 engage in conduct which the latter has a legal right to abstain from,
  8 or to abstain from conduct which he <u>or she</u> has a legal right to engage
- 9 in.

- (2) "Threat" as used in this section means:
- 11 (a) To communicate, directly or indirectly, the intent immediately
- 12 to use force against any person who is present at the time; or
- 13 (b) Threats as defined in RCW 9A.04.110(25)(a), (b), or (c).
- 14 (3) Coercion is a gross misdemeanor.
