- 1 AN ACT Relating to the benefits of sports and athletics to the

- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The office of the superintendent of public
- 6 instruction shall sponsor a conference for health professionals,
- 7 teachers, parents, administrators, persons involved in community sports
- 8 programs, and other interested parties on the impact of sports and
- 9 athletics on the health and well-being of girls. The conference shall
- 10 be held during the 1998 calendar year. The purposes of the conference
- 11 include, but are not limited to:
- 12 (1) A better understanding of the health and well-being benefits of
- 13 sports and athletics to girls of elementary school age;
- 14 (2) Identifying barriers to participation by elementary school-age

- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. The sum of twenty-four thousand nine hundred dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, from the general fund to the office of the superintendent of public instruction for the purposes of this act.
