3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **sec. 1.** RCW 43.43.350 and 1969 ex.s. c 20 s 2 are each amended to 5 read as follows:

6 Eligibility for examination ((or)) <u>for</u> promotion shall be 7 determined as follows:

8 Patrol officers with one year of probationary experience, in 9 addition to three years experience as a regular patrolman <u>before the</u> 10 <u>date of the first examination occurrence</u>, shall be eligible for 11 examination for the rank of sergeant; patrol officers with one year of 12 probationary experience in the rank of sergeant <u>before the date of the</u> 13 <u>first examination occurrence</u>, in addition to two years as a regular 14 sergeant, shall be eligible for examination for the rank of lieutenant.
