1 AN ACT Relating to selling or giving drug paraphernalia to minors; 2 adding a new section to chapter 26.28 RCW; and prescribing penalties.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 26.28 RCW 5 to read as follows:

(1) Every person who sells or gives, or permits to be sold or given б 7 to any person under the age of eighteen years any drug paraphernalia in any form commits a class I civil infraction under chapter 7.80 RCW. 8 9 For purposes of this subsection, "drug paraphernalia" means all 10 equipment, products, and materials of any kind which are used, intended for use, or designed for use in planting, propagating, cultivating, 11 growing, harvesting, manufacturing, compounding, converting, producing, 12 processing, preparing, testing, analyzing, packaging, repackaging, 13 storing, containing, concealing, injecting, ingesting, inhaling, or 14 15 otherwise introducing into the human body a controlled substance. Drug 16 paraphernalia includes, but is not limited to objects used, intended for use, or designed for use in ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise 17 18 introducing marihuana, cocaine, hashish, or hashish oil into the human 19 body, such as:

(a) Metal, wooden, acrylic, glass, stone, plastic, or ceramic pipes
 with or without screens, permanent screens, hashish heads, or punctured
 metal bowls;

- 4 (b) Water pipes;
- 5 (c) Carburetion tubes and devices;
- 6 (d) Smoking and carburetion masks;

7 (e) Roach clips: Meaning objects used to hold burning material,
8 such as a marihuana cigarette, that has become too small or too short
9 to be held in the hand;

- 10 (f) Miniature cocaine spoons and cocaine vials;
- 11 (g) Chamber pipes;
- 12 (h) Carburetor pipes;
- 13 (i) Electric pipes;
- 14 (j) Air-driven pipes;
- 15 (k) Chillums;
- 16 (1) Bongs; and
- 17 (m) Ice pipes or chillers.

(2) It shall be no defense to a prosecution for a violation of this
section that the person acted, or was believed by the defendant to act,
as agent or representative of another.
