- 1 AN ACT Relating to exemptions from driver's license requirements
- 2 for nonresidents; and amending RCW 46.20.025.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.20.025 and 1993 c 148 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 The following persons are exempt from license hereunder:
- 7 (1) Any person in the service of the army, navy, air force, marine 8 corps, or coast guard of the United States, or in the service of the 9 national guard of this state or any other state, when furnished with a
- 10 driver's license by such service when operating an official motor
- 11 vehicle in such service;
- 12 (2) A nonresident in the service of the army, navy, air force,
- 13 marine corps, or coast quard of the United States, or in the service of
- 14 the national quard of this or any other state, or the spouse or
- 15 dependent of such a person, who is at least sixteen years of age and
- 16 who has in his or her immediate possession a valid driver's license
- 17 <u>issued</u> by the jurisdiction designated as his or her home state;
- 18 (3) A nonresident who is temporarily sojourning within this state
- 19 and who is at least sixteen years of age and who has in his or her

- 1 immediate possession a valid driver's license issued to him or her in
- 2 his or her home state or is at least fifteen years of age with a valid
- 3 instruction permit issued to him or her in his or her home state, and
- 4 when accompanied by a licensed driver who has had at least five years
- 5 of driving experience and is occupying a seat beside the driver;
- 6 (((3))) (4) A nonresident who is at least sixteen years of age and
- 7 who has in his or her immediate possession a valid driver's license
- 8 issued to him or her in his or her home country may operate a motor
- 9 vehicle in this state for a period not to exceed one year;
- 10 (((4))) <u>(5) A nonresident student, or the spouse or dependent of a</u>
- 11 nonresident student, who is at least sixteen years of age and who has
- 12 <u>in his or her immediate possession a valid driver's license issued to</u>
- 13 him or her in his or her home state. The student must be enrolled as
- 14 <u>a full-time nonresident student at an institution of higher learning in</u>
- 15 Washington state that is accredited by the Northwest association of
- 16 schools and colleges or by an accrediting association recognized by the
- 17 <u>higher education coordinating board, or at a private vocational school</u>
- 18 as that term is defined by RCW 28C.10.020(7). The student must
- 19 maintain his or her legal home of record at a location outside the
- 20 state of Washington. The student must carry documentation issued by
- 21 the institution that readily establishes his or her status as a
- 22 <u>nonresident student.</u> A spouse or dependent of a nonresident student
- 23 must carry a copy of the documentation issued to the student by the
- 24 institution and documentation establishing the relationship with the
- 25 student;
- 26 (6) Any person operating special highway construction equipment as
- 27 defined in RCW 46.16.010;
- (((+5))) (7) Any person while driving or operating any farm tractor
- 29 or implement of husbandry which is only incidentally operated or moved
- 30 over a highway;
- $((\frac{6}{}))$ (8) Any person while operating a locomotive upon rails,
- 32 including operation on a railroad crossing over a public highway; and
- 33 such person is not required to display a driver's license to any law
- 34 enforcement officer in connection with the operation of a locomotive or
- 35 train within this state.
