- 1 AN ACT Relating to actions against health care providers; and
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 7.70 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 7.70 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- A health care provider, as defined in RCW 48.43.005, is not liable
- 7 to the patient or to any third-party payor or others under any contract
- 8 or policy providing or paying for health care benefits or services,
- 9 including any health plan as defined in RCW 48.43.005, which is entered
- 10 into or renewed after the effective date of this act, for the decision
- 11 of a third-party payor or others not to pay for or provide
- 12 reimbursement for health care services recommended by the health care
- 13 provider when:
- 14 (1) The health care provider complies with any formal or informal
- 15 avenues of appeal made available to the health care provider by the
- 16 third-party payor or others under a health plan, as defined in RCW
- 17 48.43.005, or under any other contract or policy providing or paying
- 18 for health care benefits or services; and

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- 1 (2) The health care provider advises the patient to obtain the 2 recommended care, even if not covered by the third-party payor, informs 3 the patient of the potential risks in not obtaining the recommended 4 health care services, and informs the patient to comply with any formal 5 or informal avenues of appeal made available to the patient by the 6 third-party payor or others under a health plan, as defined in RCW 7 48.43.005, or under any other contract or policy providing or paying 8 for health care benefits or services.
- 9 This section neither creates nor defines a standard of care for the 10 provision of such health care services.

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
