- 1 AN ACT Relating to clothing, personal maintenance, and incidental
- 2 allowances within the department of social and health services; adding
- 3 a new section to chapter 74.08 RCW; and providing an effective date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 74.08 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 To the extent allowed by federal law, the department:
- 8 (1) Shall establish a uniform monthly allowance for clothing,
- 9 personal maintenance, and necessary incidentals for all individuals
- 10 residing in state-funded residential facility beds. The allowance
- 11 shall be set no lower than the highest allowance currently authorized
- 12 on the effective date of this act. The department shall not remove any
- 13 individual from any program based on a change in his or her income or
- 14 resources attributable to the modification of the uniform monthly
- 15 allowance mandated under this section;
- 16 (2) Shall increase the uniform monthly allowance set under this
- 17 section by the same rate as authorized for any vendor rate increase for
- 18 state-funded residential facilities;

- 1 (3) May adjust an individual's uniform monthly allowance, by 2 agreement with the individual, if the allowance would effect his or her 3 eligibility to receive services under medicaid personal care, the 4 community options program entry system, or any other program providing 5 state-funded residential facilities.
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act takes effect July 1, 1998.
