
SENATE JOINT MEMORIAL 8001

State of Washington 55th Legislature 1997 Regular Session

1 TO THE HONORABLE GARY LOCKE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON,
2 AND TO THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS, AND TO THE
3 DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL ADMINISTRATION, AND TO THE
4 STATE'S VIETNAM VETERANS ORGANIZATIONS:

5 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of
6 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully
7 represent and petition as follows:

8 WHEREAS, In 1984, legislation was enacted authorizing the design
9 and placement of a memorial on the Capitol campus honoring Washington
10 state residents who died or are missing-in-action- in the southeast
11 Asia theater of operations; and

12 WHEREAS, This memorial, commonly known as the Vietnam memorial, was
13 dedicated in May 1987, and was almost totally paid for from many
14 private contributions; and

15 WHEREAS, There are over eleven hundred names engraved on the
16 memorial representing those who made the ultimate sacrifice for their
17 country; and

18 WHEREAS, many thousands of Washington state residents have died and
19 more residents will die from war-related injuries received in the
20 southeast Asia theater of operations; and

1 WHEREAS, The pain, suffering, and above all courage of these
2 Washington state residents should be recognized and honored;

3 NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the
4 Governor of the State of Washington, in consultation with the Director
5 of the Department of Veterans Affairs, the Director of the Department
6 of General Administration, and the state's Vietnam veterans
7 organizations, have placed upon the southeast Asia memorial a plaque
8 honoring those veterans who died from war-related injuries received in
9 the southeast Asia theater of operations.

10 BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this memorial be immediately
11 transmitted to the honorable Gary Locke, Governor of the State of
12 Washington, the Director of the Department of Veterans Affairs, the
13 Director of the Department of General Administration, and the state's
14 Vietnam veterans organizations.
