- AN ACT Relating to vehicle width; and amending RCW 46.44.010.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 3 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.44.010 and 1983 c 278 s 1 are each amended to read 4 as follows:
- 5 The total outside width of any vehicle or load thereon shall not
- 6 exceed eight and one-half feet: PROVIDED, That no rear vision mirror
- 7 may extend more than five inches beyond the extreme limits of the body:
- 8 PROVIDED FURTHER, That excluded from this calculation of width are
- 9 safety appliances such as clearance lights, rub rails, flexible fender
- 10 extensions, mud flaps, and splash and spray suppressant devices, and
- 11 appurtenances such as door handles, door hinges, and turning signal
- 12 brackets and such other safety appliances and appurtenances as the
- 13 department may determine are necessary for the safe and efficient
- 14 operation of motor vehicles: AND PROVIDED FURTHER, That no appliances
- 15 or appurtenances may extend more than ((two)) three inches beyond the
- 16 extreme limits of the body.
