1 AN ACT Relating to the registration of architects; amending RCW 2 18.08.350; and providing an effective date.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.08.350 and 1993 c 475 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

6 (1) A certificate of registration shall be granted by the director 7 to all qualified applicants who are certified by the board as having 8 passed the required examination and as having given satisfactory proof 9 of completion of the required experience.

10 (2) Applications for examination shall be filed as the board 11 prescribes by rule. The application and examination fees shall be 12 determined by the director under RCW 43.24.086.

13 (3) An applicant for registration as an architect shall be of a 14 good moral character, at least eighteen years of age, and shall possess 15 ((any)) <u>either</u> of the following qualifications:

16 (a) Have an accredited architectural degree and three years' 17 practical architectural work experience <u>and have completed the</u> 18 <u>requirements of a structured intern training program</u> approved by the 19 board((, which may include designing buildings as a principal activity.

At least two years' work experience must be supervised by an architect 1 with detailed professional knowledge of the work of the applicant)); or 2 3 (b) Have eight years' practical architectural work experience, 4 which may include designing buildings as a principal activity, and have completed the requirements of a structured intern training program 5 approved by the board. Each year spent in an accredited architectural 6 7 education program approved by the board shall be considered one year of 8 practical experience. At least four years' practical work experience 9 shall be under the direct supervision of an architect.

10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. Section 1 of this act takes effect July 29, 11 2001.
