- 12 as defined by RCW 88.12.025;
- 13 (b) In a reckless manner; or
- 14 (c) With disregard for the safety of others.
- 15 (2) When the death is caused by a skier towed by a vessel, the
- 16 operator of the vessel is not guilty of homicide by watercraft.

Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, the definitions in this section apply throughout this chapter.

- (1) "Boat wastes" includes, but is not limited to, sewage, garbage, marine debris, plastics, contaminated bilge water, cleaning solvents, paint scrapings, or discarded petroleum products associated with the use of vessels.
- 19 (2) "Boater" means any person on a vessel on waters of the state of 20 Washington.
 - (3) "Carrying passengers for hire" means carrying passengers in a vessel on waters of the state for valuable consideration, whether given directly or indirectly or received by the owner, agent, operator, or other person having an interest in the vessel. This shall not include trips where expenses for food, transportation, or incidentals are shared by participants on an even basis. Anyone receiving compensation for skills or money for amortization of equipment and carrying passengers shall be considered to be carrying passengers for hire on waters of the state.
- 30 (4) "Commission" means the state parks and recreation commission.
 - (5) "Darkness" means that period between sunset and sunrise.
- 32 (6) "Environmentally sensitive area" means a restricted body of 33 water where discharge of untreated sewage from boats is especially 34 detrimental because of limited flushing, shallow water, commercial or 35 recreational shellfish, swimming areas, diversity of species, the 36 absence of other pollution sources, or other characteristics.
- 37 (7) "Guide" means any individual, including but not limited to 38 subcontractors and independent contractors, engaged for compensation or

- 5 (8) "Marina" means a facility providing boat moorage space, fuel, 6 or commercial services. Commercial services include but are not 7 limited to overnight or live-aboard boating accommodations.
- 8 (9) "Motor driven boats and vessels" means all boats and vessels which are self propelled.
- 10 (10) "Muffler" or "muffler system" means a sound suppression device 11 or system, including an underwater exhaust system, designed and 12 installed to abate the sound of exhaust gases emitted from an internal 13 combustion engine and that prevents excessive or unusual noise.
- 14 (11) "Operate" means to steer, direct, or otherwise have physical control of a vessel that is underway.
- 16 (12) "Operator" means an individual who steers, directs, or 17 otherwise has physical control of a vessel that is underway or 18 exercises actual authority to control the person at the helm.
- 19 (13) "Observer" means the individual riding in a vessel who is 20 responsible for observing a water skier at all times.
- 21 (14) "Owner" means a person who has a lawful right to possession of 22 a vessel by purchase, exchange, gift, lease, inheritance, or legal 23 action whether or not the vessel is subject to a security interest.
- 24 (15) "Person" means any individual, sole proprietorship, 25 partnership, corporation, nonprofit corporation or organization, 26 limited liability company, firm, association, or other legal entity 27 located within or outside this state.
- (16) "Personal flotation device" means a buoyancy device, life preserver, buoyant vest, ring buoy, or buoy cushion that is designed to float a person in the water and that is approved by the commission.
- 11 (17) "Personal watercraft" means a vessel of less than sixteen feet 32 that uses a motor powering a water jet pump, as its primary source of 33 motive power and that is designed to be operated by a person sitting, 34 standing, or kneeling on, or being towed behind the vessel, rather than 35 in the conventional manner of sitting or standing inside the vessel.
- (18) "Polluted area" means a body of water used by boaters that is contaminated by boat wastes at unacceptable levels, based on applicable water quality and shellfish standards.

- 23 (25) "Waters of the state" means any waters within the territorial
- 24 limits of Washington state.
- 25 (26) "Whitewater river outfitter" means any person who is
- 26 advertising to carry or carries passengers for hire on any whitewater
- 27 river of the state, but does not include any person whose only service
- 28 on a given trip is providing instruction in canoeing or kayaking
- 29 skills.
- 30 (27) "Whitewater rivers of the state" means those rivers and
- 31 streams, or parts thereof, within the boundaries of the state as listed
- 32 in RCW 88.12.265 or as designated by the commission under RCW
- 33 88.12.279.
