- 1 AN ACT Relating to property tax exemptions for nonprofit
- 2 organizations; and amending RCW 84.36.043.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 84.36.043 and 1991 c 198 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) The real and personal property used by a nonprofit organization
- 7 in providing emergency or transitional housing for low-income homeless
- 8 persons as defined in RCW 35.21.685 or 36.32.415 or victims of domestic
- 9 violence who are homeless for personal safety reasons is exempt from
- 10 taxation if:
- 11 (a) The charge, if any, for the housing does not exceed the actual
- 12 cost of operating and maintaining the housing; and
- 13 (b)(i) The property is owned by the nonprofit organization; or
- 14 (ii) ((For taxes levied for collection in 1991 through 1999 only,))
- 15 The property is rented or leased by the nonprofit organization and the
- 16 benefit of the exemption inures to the nonprofit organization.
- 17 (2) As used in this section:

- 1 (a) "Homeless" means persons, including families, who, on one 2 particular day or night, do not have decent and safe shelter nor 3 sufficient funds to purchase or rent a place to stay.
- 4 (b) "Emergency housing" means a project that provides housing and supportive services to homeless persons or families for up to sixty 6 days.
- 7 (c) "Transitional housing" means a project that provides housing 8 and supportive services to homeless persons or families for up to two 9 years and that has as its purpose facilitating the movement of homeless 10 persons and families into independent living.
- 11 (3) This exemption is subject to the administrative provisions 12 contained in RCW 84.36.800 through 84.36.865.
