Brief Title: Defining medication assistance in community-based settings.

HB 2452 - DIGEST

(SUBSTITUTED FOR - SEE 1ST SUB)

Declares that "medication assistance" means assistance rendered by a nonpractitioner to an individual residing in a community-based setting to facilitate the individual's selfadministration of a legend drug or controlled substance, where a practitioner has determined, in consultation with the individual or the individual's representative, that medication assistance is appropriate. It includes reminding or coaching the individual, using an enabler, placing the medication in the individual's hand, or helping in the preparation of legend drugs or controlled substances for self-administration, and such other means of medication assistance as defined by rule adopted by the department.
