HB 2554 - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 2/12/98)

Declares that it is unlawful for a service provider to offer a claimant a cash incentive, a material incentive, or a nonmaterial incentive, regardless of actual monetary value, when a property and casualty insurance claim will be filed to reimburse the claimant for the cost of service.
