Secretary of State State of Washington 1 AN ACT Relating to methods of taking wildlife; adding a new section 2 to chapter 77.16 RCW; and prescribing penalties.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 77.16 RCW 5 to read as follows:

6 (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of RCW 77.12.240 and 77.12.265 7 or other provisions of law, it is unlawful to take, hunt, or attract 8 black bear with the aid of bait.

9 (a) Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to prohibit the 10 killing of black bear with the aid of bait by employees or agents of 11 county, state, or federal agencies while acting in their official 12 capacities for the purpose of protecting livestock, domestic animals, 13 private property, or the public safety.

(b) Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to prevent the
establishment and operation of feeding stations for black bear in order
to prevent damage to commercial timber land.

(c) Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to prohibit the director from issuing a permit or memorandum of understanding to a public agency, university, or scientific or educational institution for the use of bait to attract black bear for scientific purposes. 1 (d) As used in this subsection, "bait" means a substance placed, 2 exposed, deposited, distributed, scattered, or otherwise used for the 3 purpose of attracting black bears to an area where one or more persons 4 hunt or intend to hunt them.

5 (2) Notwithstanding RCW 77.12.240 or any other provisions of law, 6 it is unlawful to hunt or pursue black bear, cougar, bobcat, or lynx 7 with the aid of a dog or dogs.

8 (a) Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to prohibit the 9 killing of black bear, cougar, bobcat, or lynx with the aid of a dog or 10 dogs by employees or agents of county, state, or federal agencies while acting in their official capacities for the purpose of protecting 11 livestock, domestic animals, private property, or the public safety. 12 A dog or dogs may be used by the owner or tenant of real property 13 consistent with a permit issued and conditioned by the director under 14 15 RCW 77.12.265.

(b) Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to prohibit the director from issuing a permit or memorandum of understanding to a public agency, university, or scientific or educational institution for the use of a dog or dogs for the pursuit of black bear, cougar, bobcat, or lynx for scientific purposes.

(3) A person who violates subsection (1) or (2) of this section is 21 quilty of a gross misdemeanor. In addition to appropriate criminal 22 23 penalties, the director shall revoke the hunting license of a person 24 who violates subsection (1) or (2) of this section and a hunting 25 license shall not be issued for a period of five years following the 26 revocation. Following a subsequent violation of subsection (1) or (2) of this section by the same person, a hunting license shall not be 27 28 issued to the person at any time.

29 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. If any provision of this act or its 30 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the 31 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other 32 persons or circumstances is not affected.
