- On page 11, after line 29, insert the following:
- 4 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 11. Specified portions of this act shall be subject to the following effective dates:
- 6 (1) Except as provided in subsection (4) of this section, section 8 of this act is effective September 1, 1999;
- 8 (2) Section 1, subsection(3) of this act is effective April 1, 9 2000;
- 10 (3) Section 6 of this act is effective September 1, 1999; and
- 11 (4) For licensed driver's that move to this state and obtain a 12 Washington driver's license, the department of licensing shall begin 13 tracking the date when the new Washington resident first obtained his
- or her original license to drive no later than April 1, 2000."
- Effect: This amendment provides for a delayed effective date for portions of 2SHB 1147. The delays were requested by the department of licensing in order to give it time to make the necessary changes to its computer system.
- The effective date for the restricted license for novice drivers 20 who commit traffic infractions is September 1, 1999;
- The effective date for allowing the parent or guardian who authorized a minor to obtain a driver's license to revoke that license is April 1, 2000;
- The department's duty to collect and store information about where 25 a driver's license applicant took driver's education is effective 26 September 1, 1999;
- The departments duty to track the date of first licensure for licensed drivers who move here from out-of-state is effective April 1, 2000.
