5 On page 16, beginning on line 18, after "(5)" strike all material 6 through "following:" on line 26, and insert "In sentencing a first-time 7 offender the court may waive the imposition of a sentence within the sentence range and impose a sentence which may include up to ninety 8 9 days of confinement in a facility operated or utilized under contract by the county and a requirement that the offender refrain from 10 11 committing new offenses. The sentence may also include up to ((two 12 years)) one year of community ((supervision, which, in)) custody. If 13 treatment has been ordered, the period of community custody may include up to the period of treatment, but shall not exceed two years. In 14 addition to crime-related prohibitions, <u>conditions</u> may 15 include 16 requirements that the offender perform any one or more of the 17 following:"

<u>EFFECT:</u> Partially restores current law by allowing offenders sentenced under the first time offender waiver to serve up to two years of community custody if substance abuse or mental health treatment is ordered as a condition of the sentence.
